Guideline - Chemicals and banned or declarable substances - Chemicals management

Introduction

As an extension of the Bader policy, this guideline is intended to specify current requirements in the areas of chemicals and resources in the company and the supply chain.



We ensure requirements are met

1. Chemicals policy and banned or declarable substances


Safety, ecological, social and economic aspects as well as sustainability criteria must be taken into account when selecting chemicals. Decisions on the use of chemicals are made after assessing the relevant manufacturer's specifications and potential risks and opportunities, taking into account the specific application.

This applies in particular to the prevention and avoidance of health risks to our employees or customers and the protection of the environment and our facilities, taking into account the substitution of hazardous substances.

Bader attaches particular importance to the application and further development of resource-conserving technologies - characterized by the use of strategies to reduce emissions, save water and energy, use recycled materials, renewable raw materials, reuse and reprocessing.

2. Critical raw materials

The Bader Group strives to use only raw materials whose extraction, production, transportation, trade, processing and export do not contribute directly or indirectly to human rights violations, health and safety problems, environmental pollution or compliance violations.
